Unicom, AWOS and Temporary Tower

The Columbia Airport Unicom Frequency is **122.975**

The AWOS frequency is **124.65**, however it is out of service at this time.

The Temporary Tower frequency is **127.9**

The Temporary Ground frequency is **121.05**

A temporary tower will be in operation:

Saturday, June 14th between 8 AM & 4 PM

Traffic Patterns

Runway 17 is Right Traffic.

Runway 35 is Left Traffic

Pattern altitude is 3,100 ft

Noise Sensitive Areas

Please avoid flights over the following:

- Columbia State Park directly east of the airport
- Downtown Sonora
- The area 4 nm out on the 225 degree radial from Columbia Airport

Grass Runway Closure

The grass Runway 11-29 will be closed from 12 noon Thursday, June 12th through 5 PM Monday, June 16th for Fly-In parking & displays

Airport Closure & Flight Demonstrations:

The airport will be closed for flight demonstrations between 12 noon and 3 PM on Saturday. Warbird, antique, classic, experimental, and unique aircraft will be flying during this time.

There will be a Mandatory Pilots Briefing at the base of the temporary tower at 11:00 AM Saturday for all pilots wanting to fly during the flight demonstration period.

Flour Bombing & Spot Landing Contest

The flour bombing and spot landing contest will be held on Sunday between 11:45 AM and 12:15 PM. All participating pilots must attend a Mandatory Pilots Registration and Briefing at the base of the temporary tower at 10:45 AM Sunday only.
